

DOG LICENSES

NOTE: Licenses are only sold by your city, village or town treasurer

The State of Wisconsin requires that all owners purchase a license each year for all dogs over 5 months of age. Failure to license a dog could subject you to additional fines or fees. If you own rental properties or a mobile home park, you are required to inform your tenants of this law. If you are requesting a license by mail, **submit a copy of the current rabies vaccination information provided by a licensed veterinarian**, and be sure the following information is included on the rabies certificate:

- 1) Owner's name, address & phone number
- 2) Dog's name
- 3) Sex of dog & if it has been spayed or neutered.
- 4) Breed & color of dog

2026 License Fees:

Neuter/Spayed Dog	\$5.00
Unaltered Dog	\$10.00
Kennel License	\$40.00 – needed for 3 or more dogs
Late fee per dog if license	\$5.00 - this fee is in addition to the dog purchased after March 31

If you own **five or more dogs, contact the Trempealeau County Zoning Dept at (715) 538-2311 ext. 223 for more information regarding the Trempealeau County kennel ordinance.

If you own more than **12 dogs please contact County Treasurer at (715) 538-2377 ext. 219 regarding tags
