Village Hall Community Room

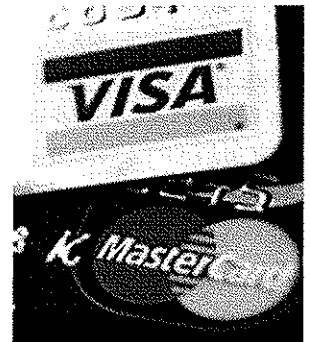

Credit/Debit Card Payments for

Taxes and Utility Bills:

We accept payments on our website, strumwi.com.

GovPayNet, the service provider, charges a convenience fee for payment processing of 2.62% of the transaction. If you have questions please call the Strum Village office at 715-695-3601.



Direct Payment for Utility Bills:

You can have your bill automatically withdrawn from your checking or savings on the date that it is due. This is a great way to pay your bill on the latest day possible and avoid late fees. If you are interested, forms are available at Village of Strum-Clerk/Treasurers Office.

Property Tax Collection:

If you are paying your taxes in person it is preferred that you pay with either a check or money order for the exact amount. **You can mail your taxes and a receipt will be mailed back to you if you provide a postage paid envelope.** Any monies due back will not be paid until after the following Village Board Meeting. If your payment is postmarked December 31, 2024 or January 31, 2025, you will get credit for paying it on that day.

BY STATE LAW ALL DOGS MUST BE LICENSED

The Village has an Ordinance for the control of dogs and cats. It is unlawful for any person owning, keeping or harboring any dog or cat to permit such dog or cat to run at large within the Village limits. **If you have more 3 or more dogs, you are required to have a kennel license. Make sure you bring proof of vaccinations.** No license will be issued without a current rabies immunization record. There is a charge of an additional fee of \$5.00 per license after March 31, 2025.

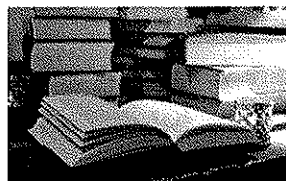

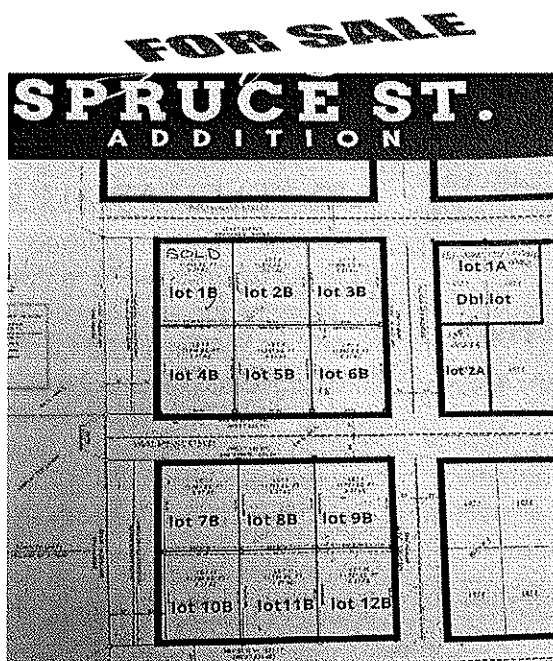
